Na competição individual, cada participante apresenta uma rotina novo cassino online solo com um dos cinco elementos: corda, bola, arco, fita e maças. A modalidade surgiu da mistura de danças clássicas e dos exercícios novo cassino online grupo com coreografia. Em 1956, novo cassino online Melbourne, aconteceu a primeira demonstração olímpica e, pouco a pouco, as rotinas com objetos passaram da ginástica artística para a rítmica. Oficialmente, a disciplina entrou no programa olímpico na edição de 1984, novo cassino online Los Angeles, com disputas individuais, e, novo cassino online equipes, 12 anos depois, novo cassino online Atlanta. Em preparação para os Jogos Olímpicos, o Portal MultiRio publica uma série de matérias sobre as diversas modalidades olímpicas e paralímpicas que são disputadas.
