"Even after we cross the \%, finish line for this deal s ap proval, we will remain focused on ensuring that Call of Duty remains available o n more \infty, platforms and for more consumers than ever before."</p> <p>Spencer did not disclose the terms of Microsoft's deal with Sony, t hough Stephen %, Totilo of Axios later confirmed that it is 10 years in duratio n. Microsoft first offered Sony a 10-year deal to %, keep Call of Duty on curre nt and future PlayStation consoles at the end of last year, though the Japanese electronics %, giant turned down the olive branch at the time. In an effort to secure approval from regulators, including the FTC %, and CMA, Microsoft went o n to sign an agreement with Nintendo to bring the series to the company's fu ture consoles. %, It also came to terms with cloud gaming providers like NVIDIA .</p> <p>Before today, Jim Ryan, the president and CEO of Sony %, Interactive E ntertainment, made clear he was strongly opposed to Microsoft's Activision b I don t want a new Call of Duty %, deal. I just want to block your merger, Ryan told Activision CEO Bobby Kotick. I told him [Kotick] that I %, the transaction was anti-competitive, I hoped that the regulators would do their Ryan later said %, during his testimony at the FTC v. Micr r job and block it, osoft hearing. But with the purchase all but set to move forward, Sony %, likel y had no choice but to come to terms with its rival.</p>
